Instrumentation:

For solo percussionist: brushes, soft and rubber mallets, finger cymbals, metal güiro, water, exposed speaker (playing low frequency sine tones and field recordings), played on two metal, water pails with moving bamboo/water pail structure.

*The work is to be realised as a performance or as part of a sound art installation.

*While 8 drums were used for this installation, future iterations of this work could include any number of these pails (10, 16, 21, 40 etc.) or for any number of percussionists so that they fill the entire space.
